## 410 Community Service Program Highlights

**1 Peter 4:10- As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace.**

The mission of Rosehill Christian School includes serving others and giving back to the community. Our desire is for each student to use their God-given gifts to serve others.

The Rosehill Christian High School Community Service project is also designed to provide valuable volunteer experiences for students and to foster relationships between RCHS and its surrounding communities. The program supports students who create their own volunteer community service projects or design their own ventures within existing volunteer organizations. Applications are evaluated on the basis of their value to the community and in terms of the value of the learning experience to the applicant. Special consideration is given for creativity and/or initiative.

-  10 service hours must be completed 2 weeks prior to first semester final exams and the remaining 15 hours completed 2 weeks prior to the second semester final exams.
-  5 of the 25 hours may be involved with the student's local church 5 of the 25 hours may come from a mission trip where students labor for others 5 of the 25 hours may come from school service.
-  Students must complete a total of twenty-five (25) hours of community service.
-  Students should earn at least 10 hours per semester.
-  Students who do not complete the 10-hour requirement will have 10 points (or the number remaining) deducted from their Bible final semester grade.
  
-  Proposal Forms for summer projects are due 2 weeks before the end of the spring semester of that school year.
-  All summer hours and school service hours that were earned during the summer or shortly after the beginning of the 2006 school year must be submitted to Mrs. Pearce by October 1, 2006 to receive credit.
