### **Methods of Payment:**

- **Payment in Full.** Payment directly to the school by check or cash by June 1, 2012.
- **Payments through FACTS.** For all deferred payments (11 monthly payments excluding February to allow for re-enrollment fees to be paid) tuition may be paid through one of the following methods:
  1. Automatic Bank Payment (ACH) budgeted through FACTS. Payment date may be either the 5<sup>th</sup> or the 20<sup>th</sup> from checking or savings account.
  2. Automatic billing to MasterCard, Discover, or AMEX with a convenience fee. Payment in full may also be made this way if you wish to collect credit card reward points for paying your tuition.

### **Withdrawals & Late Enrollees:**

- In the event a student enrolls after the first day of the school year, tuition will be pro-rated.
- All tuition and fees paid during the months of June and July are non-refundable/non-transferable.
- In the event a student withdraws after June 1, the family will be financially responsible for all tuition and fees due through the entire month the withdrawal papers are received by the Admissions Office. A student is not considered to be in the withdrawal process until withdrawal forms are submitted to the Admissions Office. At the time of withdrawal, the balance due to RCS must be paid by cash or money order before school records may be released.

### **Financial Support:**

Each year the budget is planned with an operating short-fall. RCS depends on donations and fund raising activities to fill this gap. A generous pledge/commitment to the Annual Fund ensures educational excellence for our children. Active participation is requested from each family.
